**ORDER OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION,
RESTITUTION AND CIVIL PENALTY**

This matter came on for hearing this 15th day of June, 2017, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon motion of Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities *ex rel.* Irving L. Faught, Administrator (“Plaintiff”), for default judgment against Defendant Randy Jay Doud. The Court, finding that it has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action and the issues having been heard, finds that Plaintiff’s motion for default judgment against Defendant should be granted.

The Court finds that Defendant was validly served with a summons and the petition in this case and that the date by which Defendant was required to appear and defend this action has passed. No motion or responsive pleading has been filed by or on behalf of Defendant. Defendant has thus admitted the allegations in the petition. The Court, having reviewed the evidence presented, and being fully advised in the premises, and in consideration thereof, finds that the allegations in Plaintiff’s petition are deemed true as set forth therein, and that the basis for an injunction and other equitable relief has been established by Plaintiff.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant is permanently enjoined from transacting business in and/or from the state of Oklahoma as an issuer, issuer agent, broker-dealer, broker-dealer agent, investment adviser, and/or investment adviser representative or otherwise offering and/or selling securities in and/or from the state of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant shall pay restitution to any and all investors who purchased Okie limited liability company interests, a Money Metals Investment Contract, and/or an Investment Agreement, as defined in the petition. These investors, and the amounts of restitution to be paid to each, will be subsequently determined by this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant pay a civil penalty in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to the Oklahoma Department of Securities Investor Education Revolving Fund.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of this Order.
